

## Director Biography

Sam Kalantari was born in 1976, Tehran, Ira. Is an Iranian film director, producer and writer. He is considered to be a major figure of the fourth generation of Iranian documentary filmmakers. The civil engineer graduate entered the realm of Iran's professional filmmaking scene from year 2001 after completing his academic studies in filmmaking from Ireland.

Kalantari was involved in the production of over fifteen films, including documentaries and series in different countries, he is known for being passionate about experiencing different genres. He is the recipient of various prestigious awards from international festivals of Cinema Verite and Fajr International Film Festival. His movies also has been selected by different itnternational film festivals like Visions du Réel (Switzerland).

Based on the strength of his works, some of them were screened in London, Prague, Paris and Istanbul.

Exploring different genres naming social, experimental and environmental is one of the distinctive features of his works which has been acclaimed by many critics, his unique way of narration from documentary has always been well received by the audience.





## Arash Sadeghi Lavasaninia - Writer & Producer

Was born in 1975, Tehran, Iran. He received his Diploma in creative management from UCLA, BA (Honor) in Graphic Design from Faculty of Arts and Architecture ,Azad University. Arash later began his professional career in 1997, working in Morteza Momayez's graphic studio (The founder of Iranian graphic design society). Seven years later, he found his interest in cinema with producing and filming the back stage of "Iranian Carpet" feature film, which brought him the best backstage film, in the first year the award was introduced in Shahr international film festival in Tehran.

He's also collaborated with Abbas Kiarostami as an editor of "Shirin" feature movie and the technical assistant in multiple projects.

Arash has won two more awards for "A Cube of Sugar" and "The Sensitive Floor" feature films' poster design from Iranian Cinema Celebration and the art director of the ceremony. He is currently a thriving Producer, Art director for "the Iranian Alliance Of Motion Pictures Guilds" and a the core member of White Dreams Pictures distribution film company.



## Reza Teymouri - Director of Photography

Is a director of photography. With over 25 years of experience working with several directors in different styles including more than 200 documentaries, 10 feature films and 50 shorts. During his years of activity, he won many awards, such as the "Crystal Simorgh of the Fajr International Film Festival", the "Best Cinematography Award from Kodak Company", and the "Best Cinematography of the Dubai International Film Festival".



## Mastaneh Mohajer - Editor

Was born on May 5, 1974 and is one of the most prolific editors in Iran who has edited and produced more than 100 films and has been granted with many international awards in 3 decades.

She made her international debut with "Kandahar" by Mohsen Makhmalbaf, which was nominated for Palme D'or in 2001.

Rather than Cannes Festival which she later had two more appearences with Abbas Kiarostami's "Ten" in 2002 and "Three Faces" by Jafar Panahi in 2018, Mastaneh has other international nominations in festivals like Venice, Berlinale and many more.

She was the editor of Siddiq Barmak's "Osama" which won the Golden Globe awards' best foreign film in 2003.

Mastaneh is currently the CEO of "White Dreams Pictures", which is an exclusive film distribution company based in Tehran-Iran, aiming to bring new voices to the contemporary history of cinema.



#### Ensieh Maleki - Sound Designer

Ensieh Maleki, , born in Iran. As a Supervisor of Sound Design and Re-Recording Mixer over 10 years professional work in Cinema in Iran and abroad, Ensieh has been contributing more than 60 feature-length films including fiction and documentary which have been awarded/nominated in more than 100 international film festivals including Cannes, Venice, Berlin, BAFTA, BFI, Toronto, Sundance, IDFA, Asia Pacific, Chicago, Shanghai, Tokyo, Locarno, Visions du Reel, Karlovy vary, Sheffield, Hot Docs, Bussan, Edinburgh, Goa, San Sebastian, and Krakow.

She has then headed her career in the film Industry by completing a Bachelor and subsequently a Master's Degree in Sound Design and Mix for Film, from Bournemouth Universi-

Javad Matouri started his official career in 2004 and after 15 years of experiences in VFX, he has supervised more than 100 projects in Iranian and Indian cinema. His repertoire includes award-winning Iranian movies such as the below: The Salesman (Winner of 2017 Academy Awards' Best Foreign Movie) ... and more than 100 other cinematic features. His international repertoire includes high-grossing Bollywood movies such as: Baahubali 2 (highest-grossing movie of Indian cinema) & Saaho & Syeera& 2.0 (one of the most expensive movies of Bollywood).

He has cooperated with Abed Abest in his first film (Simulation) (2017) and actually in his second one, the movie "Killing the eunuch KHAN" (2021).




#### Rassa Sheikh - First Assitance and Progamme Manager


She is currently a core member of White Dreams Pictures distribution film company.

**Tina Parsa** -Psychotherapist assistance




# Ali Akbar Sadeghi Production


